

## **Terrace Hill Endowment for the Musical Arts Junior Competition Requirements**

The first ten students to apply (provided eligibility and repertoire requirements are met) will compete at the Iowa PBS studios in Johnston on **Friday evening, February 12, 2021**.

**Eligibility:** All applicants must be in grades 9-11.

**Repertoire Requirements:** All selections must be performed from memory. **Each applicant's program must be 6-9 minutes in length, and consist of at least two distinctly contrasting selections.** Applicants not meeting these requirements, including the specified program length, will be disqualified. No changes in repertoire are allowed following submission of the application.

**Application:** Submit the official entry form along with a fee of \$20. Checks should be made payable to *THEMA*. The entry form and fee are to be postmarked no later than **January 9, 2021**. The ten approved applicants will be sent a confirmation of their participation no later than January 21, 2021. All others will have their entry fees refunded. (Please do not apply if you cannot be available the afternoon of February 13, as per the following paragraph.)

**Winners.** First, second, and third places will be named and will receive awards as follows, courtesy of Jennon Caruth, Clarity Enrollment Solutions, Minneapolis: winner, \$250; second place, \$150; third place, \$100. **These three contestants must verify that they will be available to play one of their selections as part of the Senior-level finals Saturday afternoon, February 13, and will receive their awards at the conclusion of that event.** These performances may be televised on the Iowa PBS network at a later date. In addition, any of the three top winners may be invited to perform at future Terrace Hill events.
