

Terrace Hill Endowment for the Musical Arts Senior Competition Requirements

The Senior competition will take place on **Saturday, February 5, 2022** at the Iowa PBS studios in Johnston. (Because of a facility conflict this is one week earlier than usual.)

Eligibility: All applicants must be Iowa high school seniors.

Repertoire Requirements: All selections must be performed from memory. **Each applicant's program must be 15-18 minutes in length and consist of solo repertoire from at least three different stylistic periods.** Applicants not meeting these requirements, including the specified program length, will be disqualified. No changes in repertoire are allowed following submission of the application.

Application: Submit the official entry form along with a non-refundable fee of **\$25**. Checks should be made payable to *THEMA*. The entry form and fee are to be postmarked no later than **January 3, 2022**.

Applicants are no longer required to submit a recording of their performance of the submitted repertoire. Acceptance will be based solely on meeting the repertoire requirements.

Acceptance: Applicants selected as participants will be notified no later than January 14, 2022.

Competition Schedule: All participants should be prepared to play their complete programs Saturday morning. Some or all participants will play one or more of their selections again Saturday afternoon, at the discretion of the competition judge.

Scholarships. Winner, second-place, and third-place will each be awarded a scholarship over a two-year period to enroll as a piano major or minor (piano lessons and at least one music class for a minimum of three semesters) at any Iowa college or university, with the winner receiving "The First Family of Iowa Scholarship." Scholarship amounts for 2022 are: winner, \$4,000; second-place, \$2,000; third-place, \$1,000.
