

Terrace Hill Endowment for the Musical Arts Junior Competition Requirements

The first twelve students to apply (provided eligibility and repertoire requirements are met) will compete at the Iowa PBS studios in Johnston on **Saturday morning, February 4, 2023**. (Note the change from previous years.)

Eligibility: All applicants must be in grades 9-11.

Repertoire Requirements: All selections must be performed from memory. **Each applicant's program must be 6-9 minutes in length and consist of at least two distinctly contrasting selections.** Applicants not meeting these requirements, including the specified program length, will be disqualified. No changes in repertoire are allowed following submission of the application.

Application:

- Submit the official entry form along with a fee of \$30. Checks should be made payable to *THEMA*. The entry form and fee are to be postmarked no later than **January 7, 2023**.
- Repertoire listings should be as complete as possible.
- Application forms will be available on the *THEMA* website beginning on October 1, 2022.
- Once the quota of twelve contestants has been met applications will be closed.
- The twelve approved applicants will be sent a confirmation of their participation no later than January 14, 2023. All others will have their entry fees refunded.

Winners. First, second, and third places will be named and will receive awards as follows, courtesy of Jennon Caruth, Clarity Enrollment Solutions, Minneapolis: winner, \$250; second place, \$150; third place, \$100. Any of the three top winners may be invited to perform at future Terrace Hill events.
